DAY 1: OUR CREATOR

Main Point// God is our wonderful creator

Focus Passage// Genesis 1

DAY 2: OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS

Main Point// God is our righteousness

Focus Passage// Romans 3:9-31

DAY 3: OUR SHEPHERD

Jesus promised that we would never be alone. In John 14, He reassures His disciples that even though He would no longer be physically present, the Holy Spirit would come as their Comforter—guiding, teaching, and reminding them of His truth.

Focus Passage// John 14:18-26

CAMP PACKING LIST

WHAT TO BRING

- · A fantastic attitude and a desire to draw near to God
- Bible, pen, & notebook
- Appropriate, casual clothing for four nights of Worship
- Appropriate, comfortable clothing for three days of recreation (have one set of clothes you don't mind getting messy in)
- Appropriate, comfortable clothing for the trip home
- · Closed toe shoes (For daytime activities)
- Pajamas
- Towels, washcloths, and personal hygiene items
- Bedding and pillow (twin mattress)
- Personal snacks
- · Spending money for merch store, extra snacks, etc.
- · Watch and/or alarm clock
- Bathing suits for Pool/Lake (One Piece or Tankinis are allowed)
- Trash bags for wet and dirty clothes
- Sunscreen
- · Water bottle
- Bugspray
- *Phones are allowed (As long as they don't become a distraction)



WHAT NOT TO BRING

- · Tobacco, drugs, or alcohol
- · Fireworks, water balloons, or weapons
- · Skateboards, roller skates, or roller blades

WHAT NOT TO WEAR

- · Tight clothing that reveals undergarments
- "Short" shorts or skirts (Stand with your arms by your side. If your fingertips are touching skin, your shorts or skirt should be longer for camp.)
- Spaghetti strap, halter or tube tops (Tank tops at least three fingers wide can be worn during the day, but not to evening worship.)
- · Speedos or bikinis
- Clothing that promotes alcohol, cigarettes or any other inappropriate items
- · Clothing with questionable sayings, slogans, etc.
